RESOLVED FURTHER THAT in terms of the provisions of Chapter V of the SEBI ICDR Regulations, the relevant date for determining the floor price for the Preferential Issue of the Convertible warrants is **Wednesday, May 06, 2026**, being the date 30 days prior to the date on which the meeting of shareholders is being held i.e. **Friday, June 05, 2026**, to consider the proposed preferential issue;

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT without prejudice to the generality of the above Resolution, the issue of warrants convertible into equity shares to the Proposed Allottees under the Preferential Issue shall be subject to the following terms and conditions apart from others as prescribed under applicable laws:
